







## Youth Fishing Passports By Year




### **Boxplot of Age of Current Youth Fishing Passport Holders**



### Number of Passport Holders by Age




## Licenses Purchased by Former Youth Fishing Passport Holders










## "Free-Loaders": Number of People who obtained the Free 1 Day License


